

**PRODUCT SPECIFIC CONTRACTUAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR BIOCOMPONENTS**  
**PRODUCTS (bioethanol, FAME, UCOME)**

**IN GENERAL**

The GT&C and Product Specific Contractual Terms and Conditions (PSCT) is valid for all MOL Products to be sold outside Hungary.

The current PSCT shall be applicable together with the valid GT&C.

The GT&C and PSCT shall form integral part of the Contract.

The present GT&C and PSCT are available on MOL's website ( <https://molgroup.info/en/products-and-services/general-terms-and-conditions> ) in printable version.

**PLACING ORDER, TIME OF DISPATCH**

1. Concerning the time of dispatch, the Parties' written, mutual consent shall be considered as authoritative.
2. The orders shall contain the following information: name and code number – if any – of the Product, quality, quantity, destination of the Product, consignee of the delivery, required delivery date, delivery instruction.

Additionally:

- In case of **road deliveries in Buyer's road truck**: name of the carrier and identification number of the vehicle.
  - In case of **rail deliveries in Buyer's RTCs**: name of the carrier and the list of wagon IDs.
  - In case of **barge deliveries in Buyer's barge**: name of the barge.
3. Seller shall send a dispatch advice containing the date of dispatch, the weight of the goods delivered and the identification – number or name – of the vehicle, no later than on the first working day after dispatch of the Product.

**SUSTAINABILITY**

***As the delivered Product includes the percentage of sustainable bio-component, a Proof of Sustainability (PoS) shall be issued after the physical dispatch, **not latest as 30 days**, to demonstrate the compliance with all sustainability – and greenhouse gas emission saving criteria set in the Renewable Energy Directive (2009/28/EC). By default, MOL uses ISCC-EU (International Sustainability and Carbon Certification) system. In case of any other **voluntary scheme which is officially approved by the European Commission**, MOL has to be informed previously in written form, and approve this condition before the deal. This shall be applied also for PoS issued from Nabisy Database.***

*Seller shall send the required PoS together with the other accompanying documents of the shipments as well as in electronic format via e-mail no later than 30 days following the date of the physical dispatch of the Product. If the PoS does not include all the information what is required by ISCC-EU standard, Seller must send an individual declaration via e-mail about the missing data at the same time with the issued PoS. In lack of the required PoS / information after 30 days of the physical dispatch, Buyer is entitled to postpone the payment of the delivery until Buyer receives the required PoS.*

#### **COMPLAINS**

*The Buyer shall declare in writing acceptance of the Seller's quality claims within 2 working days following receipt thereof. Method of any subsequent sampling and testing with the objective of investigating Buyer's quality claims shall be agreed by the Parties.*

*Should the investigation of complaint not lead to the settlement thereof, the Parties shall involve an independent third party expert/laboratory with the proper accreditation in the investigation. Such independent third party expert's position shall be considered as decisive and shall be accepted by the Parties.*

*Costs arising on account of involvement of the independent third party expert shall be borne by the party whose claims are not justified. In case of Seller's justified quality claims Buyer shall remedy the defective performance within 15 working days*
