„High risk works (Regardless of complexity) from 1st of January 2017. can only perform by

- contractors, who have an SCC system certification issued by an accredited certification body for their company (valid for 3 years)
- Employees, who have an individual SCC certification issued by an accredited certification body (valid for 10 years))”
- High-risk works cannot be contracted without an SCC certificate





# Previously Asked Questions



*As a general contractor, the company will carry out the works critical from HSE point of view with subcontractors.*

*Does the general contractor need to obtain certification?*

**If you want to apply for a project that includes high-risk work, it is a condition that you have the necessary SCC / VCA certification for such work. If a subcontractor is to be involved, those who will carry out high-risk work must have the necessary certification.**

*Is other ISO / MEBIR / EIR / KIR / BISNODE or special audit certificates that are quasi-equivalent to SCC acceptable?*

**No.**

*Our company performs parts delivery to you from abroad. Any other maintenance activity required may be performed by our authorized service representative. In this case, do I need an SCC certification?*

**To perform parts delivery, you don't need SCC certification.**

*Is an SCC certification required for a company to perform engineering activities related to the performing technical design?*

**The technical design activity on its own will not be considered as a high-risk work as long as the collection of information required for the design does not involve a high-risk activity such as for example work in confined space, work at height, thus, SCC certification is not required by default.**

# Previously Asked Questions



*What level of certification does MOL require?*

**MOL does not require a separate certification level. We expect SCC \* or SCC \*\* certification as specified in the standard. And congratulations on sustainable SCC<sup>P</sup> certification**

*We have a contract with MOL as a 3-person main contractor. Every work is carried out by subcontractors. is it enough to get an SCC \* certification?*

**No. A subcontractor may not be employed in a relevant activity with an SCC \* certification.**

*Subcontractors working for MOL must also obtain SCC certification?*

**Yes, if they perform high-risk work activity.**

*Our company carries out high-risk work for MOL with only a very small number of employees. Is it necessary to certify the whole company?*

**No. It is sufficient to certify only this part of the organization / activity.**

*Those who have been employed by MOL for more than 3 months and those who have been employed for more than 3 months but still belong to 10% - either because there was no exam, because the exam has to be repeated, etc. - in any way - e.g. under the supervision of a candidate - can they perform high-risk work?*

**No. This is due to the fact that MOL does not examine how many months the employee has been with the company and to what percentage of the employee the employee belongs. (This will be a thankful task for the certifying auditors) We also welcome fresh staff working for no more than 3 months and professionals in the '10% ', but high-risk work can only be performed by employee with an individual certification.**

*Can companies pass on the cost of certification to their prices?*

**Prices will be discussed during purchase price negotiations.**

*What levels of management does MOL expect management certification to have?*

**MOL has no specific expectations in this regard. It is up to each certified company / organization to determine at which management levels to obtain a personal management certification. According to the standard, those who involved in the operational management of employees must have a management certification.**
